THINK TANK and PARISH COUNCIL RETREAT DAY

It is so good that the Byron Parish has developed and adopted such a courageous and visionary Mission Action Plan. It clearly sets out to nurture and empower our current church family, as well as creatively setting out to connect with the community, to share the good life of faith in Jesus.

While we have an excellent Mission Action Plan, it is now necessary to tackle just how this can be implemented on the ground. We need some wise input and discussion, that will enable us to decide where, when, and how, we are going to use the current five worship locations in our new parish. We now have one parish and one Ministry Leader (Rector) whose role it is to conduct the current worship in the parish in a practical and effective way.

The role of our Parish Community Minister is clearly to focus on the mission to those beyond the life of the church with a view to developing new missionary ways of being church. This role is vital to the future and the courageous decision of the Parish to appoint Rosie to that role, now calls us to release her into this strategic ministry.

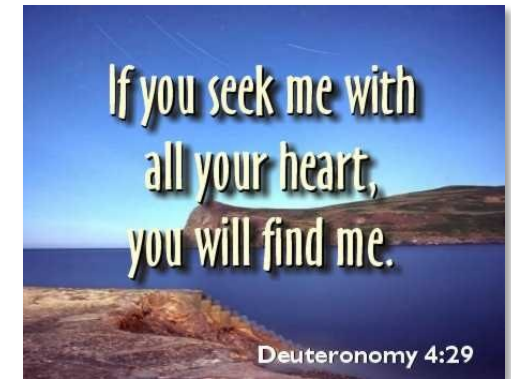
