Vaccination Update

Bishop Murray has written this week to clarify the situation regarding vaccination and worship as part of the NSW Government recovery plan:

"Dear Sisters and Brothers

Vaccination Status and Public Worship from 11 October

By now you will have heard the government's announcement that from 11 October unvaccinated people will not be allowed to participate in public worship.

While this will be for a short period, from 11 October until such time as NSW reaches the vaccination rate of 80% (of the 16+ Population) - probably about two or three weeks, it will mean that we will sadly need to exclude the unvaccinated from our churches during this time."

Please understand that it will be necessary for the parish to comply with Public Health Orders once issued, which we have been following since the beginning of the current global pandemic.

Be assured that your parish leadership will be diligent in caring for our parish family during this latest challenge. If you have any concerns, please do not hesitate to speak with me or a member of our leadership team.
