#### **From Grahame**

The Old Testament reading this week continues a theme of faithfulness in adversity. Naomi and Ruth remained faithful to each other when their respective situations might have allowed otherwise. They remained faithful and in so doing took their place in God's purposes.

Years ago, Brenda and I were asked to host a priest from the United Kingdom, 'Out Back'. After our visitor returned home, we stayed in touch which is how I came to know this story. In the vagaries of the Anglican Communion, our colleague came to have a special responsibility for the Church in New Guinea. This led to accompanying the then Archbishop of Canterbury while visiting isolated communities there. Many of these communities could only be reached by a reasonably small plane. At one of these isolated communities, they were waiting to take off when the pilot announced that the plane was too heavy and so they needed someone to volunteer and stay behind. Silence.... The silence went on for so long that my friend was about to volunteer, reasoning that it was the Archbishop who needed to be at the next function not him. Just then a young couple stood up at the back of the plane and left. They were applauded.

At the next gathering the Archbishop was presented with an artwork which it was hoped he would take home and present to the Queen. The artwork was made up of contributions from a number of the youth of the region and it was presented to the Archbishop by the young girl who had coordinated the project. Unfortunately, her parents could not be there to witness this proud moment in their daughter's life because they had earlier given up their seats on the plane which had enabled the Archbishop to be there to receive the gift from their daughter.

We each have our part. Because my colleague didn't get off the plane, he became a witness to this story so that you could read it now. The Archbishop was there so that the goal of a community activity could be fulfilled. The parents of the coordinator also played an essential part in bringing that
