

From Grahame

In recent weeks our worship has focused on themes of hope, peace, joy, and love as we prepared to celebrate again the coming among us of Jesus. Now Christmas is upon us. Our journeys through this year may have been very different and so our experience of Christmas will be different to each other and that's okay. For some there may be a sense of relief at having reached the end of another year. For others perhaps a sense of achievement. Widespread rain has brought a record harvest for some and flood and heartbreak for others. In the pandemic world we are seeing an easing of restrictions, maybe the singing of carols for Christmas, if we behave, if we do the right thing.

In these hectic days of more work to do and more opportunities to gather, what is it we are taking with us from our time of isolation and restriction? I hope we may have realised how independently strong each of us are even as we recognise our interdependence on each other. What hurts one of us diminishes all. The ever-present danger is that we may become too inward focused, believing we don't need anyone else, believing we are better off alone. When we are able to lean on each other in our need and offer this same gift to others, we increase resilience and build stronger communities together.

Another danger is that we may enlarge even further the gulf between the 'haves and the have nots', suggesting that our success or otherwise is all about being prepared. But how do you prepare for occurrences such as a pandemic, the like of which has not been known for a century and that, with contemporary means of travel, might show up anywhere within hours? How do we prepare for situations which have never happened before?

It is my hope that we will take into this new beginning a memory of some of the challenges of our experience and an increased sense of empathy for others, an increased love for one another, and through this our amazing community might
