### Baptism



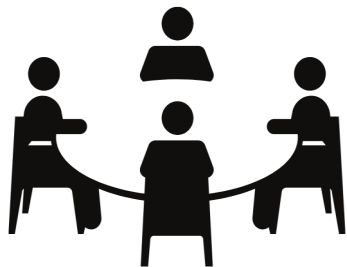
Today we warmly welcome Sage Alora Ethell who comes with her family and friends to be baptised among us .
