## From Grahame



Since mid-February we have been enjoying worship in each of our four main church buildings and coming together one Sunday afternoon per month for combined worship. With shorter winter days it has been suggested that our 4 pm combined worship be moved to 11 am. Our first gathering in this way will be at 11 am on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> of June, in St Paul's Byron Bay when we will celebrate the Day of Pentecost followed by a bring and share meal. Now that our ministers have had the opportunity to get to know the centres for which they have primary responsibility, we will be moving between worship centres more often, staying in touch with congregations across the parish.

Through conversations about the parish, I am aware of the diversity of opinion on the cause and effect of climate change. What is beyond question is that we are called to be faithful stewards of the resources provided to us. To this end I have asked parish council to consider our becoming a carbon neutral organisation.
