From Grahame

For those following the calendar of the Church there has been a lot happening. We have experienced a time of particular prayer for reconciliation, reconciliation with God and with each other; a week of prayer for Christian unity, remembering that unity is not sameness; we have celebrated the great joy of the revelation of the Holy Spirit to all people at Pentecost, and this week we are focusing on God as Trinity, God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. This concept of God has messed up a lot of people for a lot of years. Some scholars have spent their whole lives writing about this one thing. This Sunday preachers throughout the world will say 'the Trinity is like'. Like many things we do not necessarily have the words to describe the greatness of God.

As Christians we know Jesus as our Saviour, the man who died for us and that makes him central in our lives and very special to us. We also know about God our creator who made the world and put us in it. Last week we celebrated the Day of Pentecost to remind us we are not alone. We have the Holy Spirit with us to guide and enable us in the world. These three aspects are one God and that is what we call the Blessed or Holy Trinity. The most important thing is to not let our striving to have the best explanation for the Trinity become an obstacle to our lives of faith. That is the last thing God wants.



On this Trinity weekend may we be mindful of the gift of our very being through God the Father, the example and most important free gift of our reconciliation and salvation through God the Son, and the leading of God the Holy Spirit
