

The Visit of the Archbishop of Canterbury to Grafton Diocese



The Archbishop of Canterbury is the senior bishop of the Communion Analican Churches and is the spiritual leader of the world's 85 million Anglicans. Archbishop Welby will visit Australia from 4-14 October 2022 accompanied by his wife, Mrs Caroline Welby. He is scheduled to meet Analicans across the country who are involved in delivering diverse ministries and services.

His visit to Grafton Diocese on 13 and 14 October will be focused on disaster recovery following the devastating floods in the region during February and March 2022. He will meet representatives of Lismore Parish, Anglicare North Coast and organisations that are playing other a part disaster recovery in the region. The Archbishop has spoken extensively about climate change, and has been at the forefront of climate change initiatives.

The Archbishop will also give a public lecture entitled Building Peace in Robust Diversity at Emmanuel Anglican College on Thursday night 13 October. This will be the first visit of an Archbishop of Canterbury to Grafton Diocese since the visit of Archbishop Geoffrey Fisher in 1950. It will be an honour to welcome Archbishop and Mrs Welby to the Diocese and I'm sure the visit will be a great encouragement to Anglicans on the North Coast. Dr Murray Harvey Bishop of Grafton
