The revelation of God's love which Jesus preached, lived for, died for and then lived again to prove, was confronting and challenging for all who heard it, it still is. The greatest temptation of the prince of lies is to whisper – 'God didn't really mean love 'those' people'.

Interpretations of purity have been used to excuse every act of persecution of the powerless throughout history. Paul warns that these whispers will be there trying to find a work around to God's love, they will encourage busybodies to stray from God's work.

The next time we are telling God how hard life is, spare a moment to consider that God has been there before us, as one of us, willing to be hurt and suffer the greatest of pain out of love for us. God is not only God in our victories and accomplishments but more importantly, God is God when we hurt and when we fall short. As God's instruments of the Church universal, may our actions match our word's and may we never tire of doing what is right.
