From Grahame

Last week we reflected on our shared journey of 'becoming' as Christians. In the final part of our reading today we hear of the conversion of a Samaritan city. This was a point in their journey when the people of that city went from hearing God's word from another, to hearing the word for themselves – and this was accomplished in two days. In just two days the people of the city were able to go from head learning to heart learning, or maybe Jesus' words just went straight to their hearts? In Jesus' encounter in Samaria we are reminded that no one group holds a monopoly on receiving God's grace. Through Jesus Christ, there are no outsider.

Since I came to this parish many people have asked me what I would be doing. I even had someone be so bold, so honest, as to say they were looking forward to seeing what I was going to do, like I was the new fix-it person or maybe a street artist with people stopping to watch. Apart from the obvious, I believe God has call me to this place at this time in the history of creation to be with the people of this parish and communities as we discern God's call. To understand what it is about our situations which needs to be put down and what new challenges we may be called to take up. By the grace of God, I pray this will be our journey together.

Jesus speaks of living water. When we answer God's call and follow in the way of Jesus, we may be living water to those we meet. In the midst of his tiredness at the well, Jesus ministers to others, (also meets our needs). He could have said 'give me a drink and leave me to rest'. Instead, he engaged a stranger, a foreigner, and an outsider so that through him, (though) Christ, there may be no outsiders.

Through this coming week, may we set aside some time to rest at the well, allow the life giving water which Jesus brings to wash over us, and then make an effort to speak with someone we might not normally speak to. Not just a g'day as
