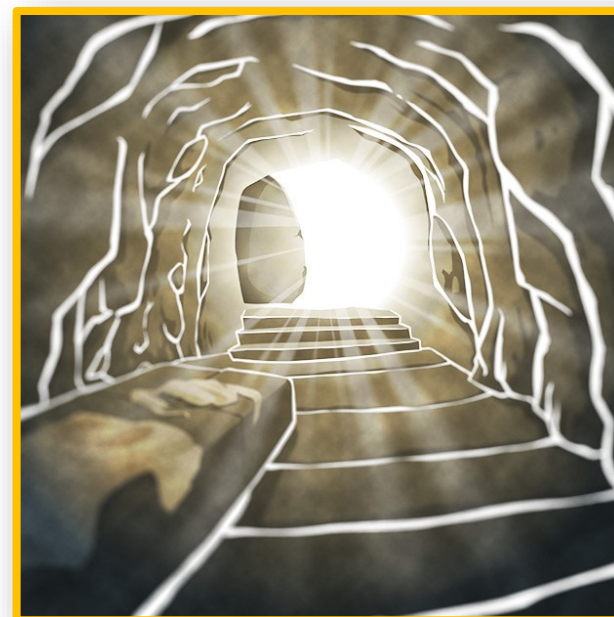
We, acknowledge the Bundjalung people, traditional custodians of this land.

From Grahame

This Sunday we celebrate that the cave in which they laid Jesus' body was empty. Christ is risen, alleluia! We will light new Paschal candles in our worship with symbols which remind us of Jesus the Christ, the Alpha and Omega, the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet, signifying Christ yesterday, today and tomorrow. On Palm Sunday we began Holy Week with the waving of palms and shouts of hosanna. We spoke about the turmoil in the community at that time, which caused the people to choose the stability of the Roman peace of oppression and hand Jesus over to be crucified; we reflected on the unwillingness of people to acknowledge what Jesus has won for us and the desire to try to get by without God. Sunday and every day, we celebrate that the tomb in which they laid Jesus dead body is empty.

If you have the opportunity to eat some chocolate eggs this weekend, try to find a hollow one. As you break into it, take a moment to be reminded that the chocolate egg, like the cave on that first Easter morning is empty, and go looking for Jesus. He is risen alleluia!
