Help Russell Trickey fight cancer

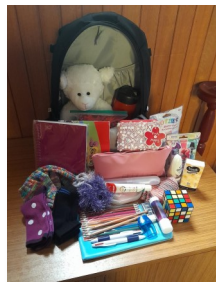

However, it may have been during Paul's imprisonment in Caesarea that he began these books.

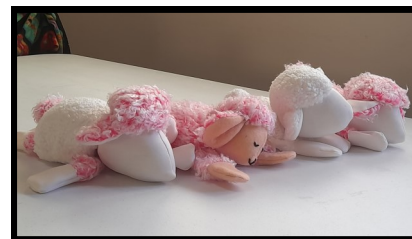


Pentecost in the Parish
