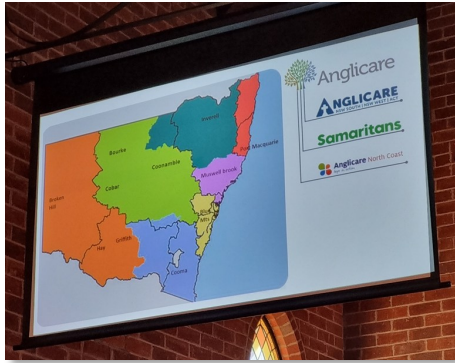

## From Grahame



Last week the parish welcomed trainers from Anglicare Disaster Resilience Sydney and North Coast. In St Martin's Mullumbimby and All Souls Bangalow, members of the parish and wider community had an opportunity to consider training as Anglicare Disaster Volunteers so as to

be able to serve our community in times of disaster. Thank you to all those who made this opportunity possible and assisted in the sessions. We know a little of disasters in our area. There are still many who experience fear at the sound of rain yet as a wise member of our congregation reflected to me just the other day, "without rain there is no life".

As we reflect on Luke 9 this Sunday, Jesus is faced with a lack of hospitality, an unwillingness to share from people who see his group as different as they travel through a foreign land. In the face of being denied basic sustenance the reaction of some in the group is to suggest using God's power to destroy. This is not the way of Jesus and Jesus rejects it.

What Jesus was said to the group, and to us today, is that he has a new way of looking at things, a new way of living. But we can never move on to new things until we are willing to put the past to rest. Leave behind attitudes and ideologies which bring division and follow in the cooperative way of Jesus, sharing and sharing in the fruits of the Spirit.


### Cursillo REGENER8 weekend.
