

From Grahame

This week in our pattern of Bible readings, we jump ahead in the narrative according to Matthew from the calling of the first followers of Jesus and the sermon on the mount, to the Transfiguration of Jesus. We do this now because the season is about to change. On Tuesday many will observe Shrove Tuesday, perhaps over pancakes, before gathering in worship for the beginning of the season of Lent on Ash Wednesday. (see notices in today's Bulletin).

In many cultures important things happen on mountaintops so it is fitting that in our calendar, we celebrate this particular mountaintop revelation of Jesus' continuity with the Old Testament, as a transition into our reflection over the coming weeks on his journey to Jerusalem, and the commemoration and celebration of the Easter mysteries.

My regular suggestion as we move into Lent and perhaps consider giving up chocolate or some other indulgence as a penitential act, is to consider giving up something which could really make a difference in our communities. Perhaps we could give up a grudge we are carrying, or a prejudice against someone who sees the world differently. Three of our church buildings still carry the banners proclaiming *Peace on Earth*. What negative might we be able to give up so that we may have room for this possibility.
